

Dry Bean Inoculant Trial – Single vs No Inoculant

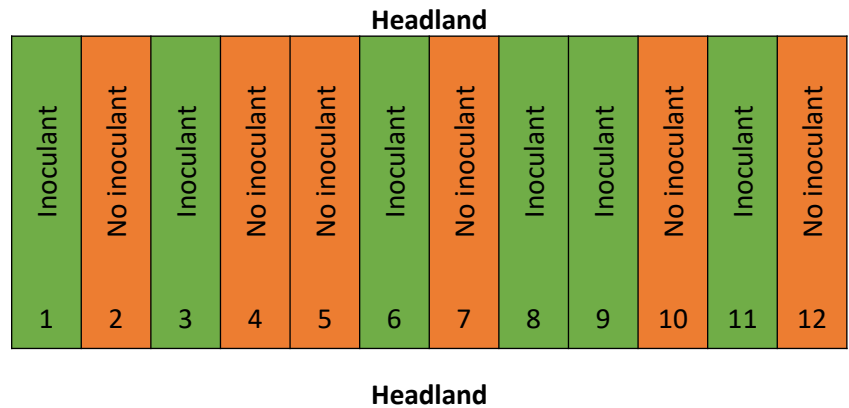
Objective: To quantify the agronomic impacts of seed applied or in-furrow inoculant on dry beans

Treatments

- 1) Single inoculant – seed applied or in-furrow
- 2) No Inoculant

Trial Design

- Randomized and replicated strip trial
- Strips need to be at least as wide as one combine pass
- Strips should run the length of the field, excluding the headlands



Farmer Requirements

- Establish the with your own equipment trial using a provided plot plan
- Manage the trial area the same as the rest of the field
- Harvest the strips using a provided weigh wagon, or appropriate grain cart, to collect accurate yield data
- Be a member in good standing with MPSG

MPSG Requirements

- Provide research support by being available during trial set-up and harvest
- Collect data from the trial throughout the growing season
- Provide a report for your trial and a summary of similar trials
